

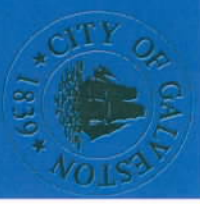

- \$10, 807 Cubic Yards of concrete

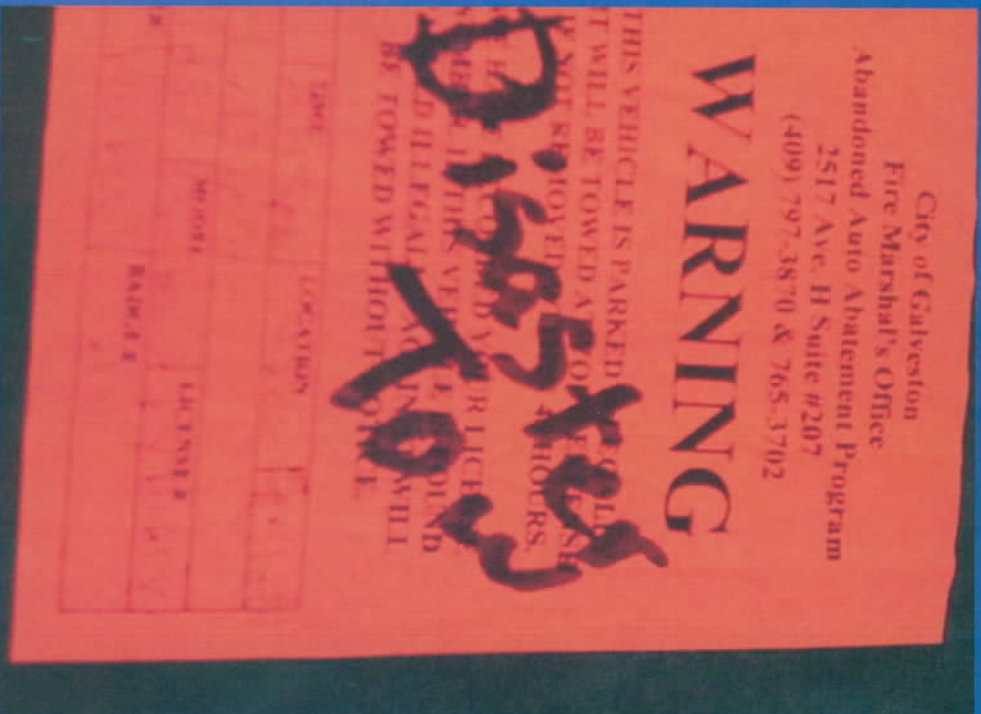


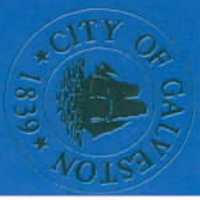

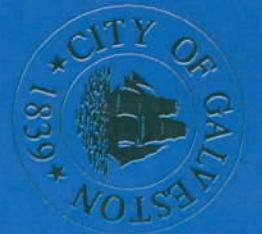




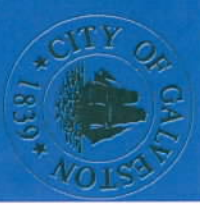
Beach Debris
