

LIMITED GOVERNMENT

- Despite the Recent Increase in Bill Filings Process is Designed to Produce Limited Government
- Historical Passage rate is only 20% or 80% of Filed Bills Fail to Pass
- Increase in Volume is Straining Legislative Process
- Forces Reliance on Staff, Opinion Leaders, & Lobbyists to Vet Bills

COMMITTEE PROCESS IS VITAL

- Committees form the backbone of the legislative process
- Chairmen wield almost unilateral power over bills in their committee
- Vast majority of work on bills occurs in committee
- Know the Rules or Pay the Consequences
- Last stop for most bills

RULES ARE MADE TO BE BROKEN

- House and Senate Rules Detail All Functions
- Calendar Deadlines Play a Significant Role
- Rules routinely "suspended" or "reinterpreted"
- Key Rule Provisions
 - House Rule 4: Outlines "Organization, Powers, and Duties of Committees" (common point of order)
 - Senate Rule 5.13 ("2/3rds Rule"): "Suspend the regular order of business"; 11 Senators Control
