- The City Attorney represents Ethics Board.

- The City Attorney is hired and compensation is set by the City Council.
- A Citizen files an ethics complaint against 5 of the 7 City Councilmembers.

- The City Attorney cannot represent the Ethics Board in the investigation of a majority of the City Councilmembers.
- City Attorney's interest (in remaining as City Attorney), and the City's interest, are adverse

### DEALING WITH THE CLIENT YOU CAN'T FIRE

- Without prior consent, a lawyer who personally has formerly represented a client in a matter shall not, thereafter, represent another person in a matter adverse to his former client:
  - (1) in which such other person questions the validity of the lawyer's services or work product for the former client;
  - (2) if the representation in reasonable probability will involve a violation of Rule 1.05; or
  - (3) if it is the same or a substantially related matter.
