



AV LEGISLATION UPDATE

- H.R. 3388 "SELF DRIVE Act"
 - Passed House by voice vote on 9/6/17
- S.1885 "AV START Act"
 - Passed out of Senate Commerce, Science, and Transportation Committee on 10/4/17
- At least 22 states and D.C. have passed AV legislation; 10 states have Executive Orders
 - (See National Conference of State Legislatures Website)







ONGOING POLICY DISCUSSION

- NHTSA Docket: 2018-0009
- Comments Filed:
 - Lack of minimum safety standards
 - Avoid preemption overreach
 - Infrastructure Needs and \$\$\$
 - Data sharing
 - Federally funded pilot programs (AV Proving Grounds and Connected Vehicle Pilot Program)
 - Coordination with Existing USDOT Programs







WHAT ABOUT THE "P" WORD?

- TX SB 2205: [City] or a state agency may not impose a franchise or regulation related to the operation of an automated motor vehicle or automated driving system
- H.R. 3388: "...unless the law or regulation is an unreasonable restriction on the design, construction, or performance of highly automated vehicles, automated driving systems, or components..."
- S. 1885: more narrow and connected to safety evaluation report subject areas, which include "system safety," "data recording," and accounting of applicable "traffic laws"







STATE AND LOCAL LAWS?

- Where to start?
 - Review and Update vs. Start Over
 - Some "simple" issues:
 - Definition of "driver"
 - Definition of "tailgating"
 - "Design immunity" protections
 - Public records exemptions
 - More complicated:
 - Insurance
 - Impact Fees
 - Consumer Rights / Data Ownership
