ROAD CONSTRUCTION LITIGATION

Lessons from experience

L. S. EQUIPMENT CO. INC. dba LONE STAR EQUIPMENT COMPANY v. CITY OF PALESTINE

- Construction of a road from a U.S. Highway to a poultry plant being constructed in the City of Palestine
- Important that road be usable in time to get plant operating
- Texas Department of Agriculture project grant paid for ½ of costs

L. S. EQUIPMENT CO. INC. dba LONE STAR EQUIPMENT COMPANY v. CITY OF PALESTINE

- Lone Star sued the city for breach of contract
 - Failure to pay what was owed under the contract
 - Under the immunity waiver of Chapter 271, Texas Local Government Code
 - Jury verdict for almost a half million dollars, exclusive of attorney's fees and interest


- Preconstruction Meeting
 - Contractor expressed concern about use of road during construction project
 - Lesson learned –
 document
 understandings about
 concerns

- Slow start
 - Concern expressed by city officials that contractor wasn't getting started quickly enough
 - Lesson learned <u>document</u> concerns about delays in construction



- Survey
 - Contractor claimed to not have survey data for entire project
 - Project scope changed as budget changed

• Lesson learned – <u>document</u> when survey documents are delivered




- Extra Material
 - Contractor claimed to have placed "a lot" more material than
 specifications called for
 - Lesson learned <u>document</u> when claim for additional material is mentioned
 - Lesson learned <u>document</u> that claims procedure must be followed



 - First involvement of counsel
 - Contractor changed counsel
 - Lessons learned counsel should be involved earlier

Dear Mr. Pruitt:

This letter is to inform you that the City of Palestine is terminating the contract between Lone Star Equipment Company, Inc. (contractor) and the City of Palestine (owner) for the construction of Sanderson Farms Parkway as identified in the contract under General Contract Conditions for Construction Item # 9 A and B effective August 3, 2015.

The reason for termination is that you have informed the project Engineer, Gary Burton via phone conversation on July 20, 2015 that you have no intentions of performing any more work until you get several issues resolved that you claim you need to be compensated for. You were informed by the emailed punch list on June 24, 2015 that the last course of type "D" mix asphalt has failed and is not acceptable. You have made no effort to contact the Engineer or the owner on what your intentions are regarding this issue.

The original time for the completion of this contract was for 150 calendar days and you have received two 30 day extensions due to weather conditions, which ended April 12, 2015. In the contract under General Contract Conditions for Construction item # 11 A through C, all disputes shall not hinder the contractor from continuing with the work under protest.

We are also sending a copy of this letter to Colonial American Casualty and Surety Company (reference bond #PRF09147094) so they will be aware of this notification as directed under General Contract Conditions for Construction item # 9. By this letter, we request that Colonial immediately take the necessary steps to complete the project according to the terms of the contract.

 - City issued notice of default
 - Lessons learned Read the contract








POST MORTEM

Experts

- Make sure that experts are well-versed and easily understood
 - Experts who worked on the project may not be the best witnesses
 - Experts who state
 absolutes and then back
 off are not the best
 witnesses
 - Penny-wise and pound foolish



POST MORTEM

- State standard contracts
 - Presume that the language is pro-city
 - But there is language that can be used to be procontractor
 - Jury is not concerned with contract language
 - Summary Judgment
 - Appeal


